

iFIBER Communications Remote Button Guide

Device Keys – Used to select which device the remote will control. Note: To control the set top box the “STB” button must be selected.

RCU SETUP – Used to program the remote to control other devices.

DVR List – Takes you directly to your list of recorded programs.

Skip Back Arrow – Jump back 15 seconds.

Rewind – Rewind 2x, 15x, 50x and 300x real time.

Stop – One press will stop Rewinding or Fast Forwarding; a second press takes you to “live” TV. While watching PVR/DVR content Stop will take you directly to “live” TV.

Menu – Takes you into the user interface menu.

Guide – Takes you into the channel guide. While in the channel guide the guide key is used to change which channels are available to view including any favorites lists that have been created.

Colored Keys – Execute specified command when prompted.

VOL +/- – Increases or decreases volume.

VOD – Takes you directly to the VOD (Video On Demand) selections. Note: This feature is currently not available.

Mute – This will mute the audio.

Number Keys – Used to manually enter desired channel numbers or passwords.

PIP, SWAP, MOVE, PHONE, WWW, SAP – Note: These features are currently not available.

INPUT – changes the desired input into your television. Note: the remote must be programmed to your television for this feature to work.

Master Power – Turns the selected device on and off.

View Live TV – Takes you to “live” TV if you have used the pause or rewind keys.

Skip Forward Arrow – Jump forward 30 seconds. Note: This feature will not work if you are watching “live” TV.

Fast Forward – Fast forward 2x, 15x, 50x and 300x real time.

Play – Overrides Rewind, Fast Forward and Pause to play Video.

Pause – Pauses Video.

Info – While watching TV or PVR/DVR one press displays basic program information a second press displays more detailed information and a third press removes the information screen.

Arrow Keys – Allow you to navigate up and down, right and left in the user interface.

OK – Selects highlighted option in the user interface.

Exit – Takes you directly to full screen video from anywhere in the user interface.

PG +/- – Ascends or descends entire page when in the guide.

Day +/- – This feature is not currently available.

CH +/- – Increases or decreases the channel number that you are watching. It can also be used to navigate up and down through the channels in the user guide.

Network – This feature is currently not available.

Last – Takes you back to the previous channel.

CC – Activates closed captioning when available.
